2. Information We Collect

2.1 Personal Information

We request personal information such as your name, phone number, email address, and company name when you ask for an account at Graffco, Inc., or if you exchange communications with us. Personal information can also include information about any transactions when using our website. Phone calls might be recorded for quality assurance. We reserve the right to keep any conversation held through contacting us by email and may collect content provided from you when interacting with our site (www.graffco.com). We use this information to operate and provide detailed features and functions for the user to further improve their experience.

2.2 Analytical Information

We might directly collect analytics data or use third party analytics tools and services to help us measure traffic and usage trends for the information provided on our website. These third-party tools collect information sent over by your web browser or mobile device, including information that aids us in refining overall customer experience. This information contains your IP address, geographical location, browser type, referral source, length of visit and pages viewed.

2.3 Payment Information

Graffco, Inc., collects and processes payment information through third party PCI-complaint service providers. This information includes credit card numbers and billing information.

3. How We Use Information We Collect

3.1 Compelled Disclosure

We reserve the right to use or disclose your Personal Information if mandatory by law or if we reasonably believe that use or disclosure is obligatory to protect our rights, protect your safety or the safety of others, investigate fraud, or comply with a law, court order, or legal process.

3.2 Corporate Events

If we (or our assets) are attained by another company, whether by merger, acquisition, bankruptcy or otherwise, that company would receive all information collected by Graffco, Inc., on the website and other means of communication. In this event, you will be informed via email and/or prominent notice on our website, of any change in ownership and the uses of your Personal Information.

3.3 External Websites

Our website provides links to other websites. We do not manage and are not responsible for the content or practices of these other websites. Our provision of such links does not establish our endorsement of these other websites, their content, their owners, or their practices. 3.4 Internal Transfer of Information

To facilitate our operations internationally, we might transfer and access Personal Information from around the world, including the United States. This Privacy Policy shall apply even if we transfer Personal Information to other countries.

3.5 Public Forums

3.6 Retention of Personal Information

If requested, we will provide you with access to all your information stored while interacting with us before eliminating the data. We might, unless legally prohibited, erase all customer information, including your Personal Information, from our records.

3.7 Security of Your Personal Information

Graffco, Inc., will never sell your Personal Information or payment information to any third party; we do not govern how any third parties use the Personal Information.

Our third-party tools use a variety of security technologies and procedures to help protect your Personal Information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. They secure the Personal Information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. When sensitive Personal Information (such as credit card number and/or geo-location data) is collected on our website and/or transmitted to other websites, it is protected using encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.

3.8 Use of Credit Card Information

If you give us credit card information, we will keep your information on file and collect payment from you. We use a third-party service provider to manage credit card processing. This service provider is not allowed to store, retain, or use information you provide except for the sole purpose of credit card processing on our behalf.

3.9 Use of Personal Information

We may use your Personal Information:

4.1 Advertising

4.2 Cookies

We use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is positioned on your hard disk by a web server. One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time.
